Dominic Pettit was runner up in round one plus a sterling drive at Mallory Park from the back of the grid to come home fourth proved he has pace.

Lloyd too has been a race winner this year; Farndon inherited one at Croft and Walkinshaw has had three podiums in the last four races. Can they get the better of the title challengers for wins themselves? One thing's for sure – there is no margin for error because there'll be someone right there to pick up the pieces!
