## Juniors at Speedy Snetterton



**12-13th July - Rounds 13 & 14 - Preview:  
The Ginetta Junior Championship**



It's Dino Zamparelli's Championship to lose at the moment, but as others begin to close in, will cracks appear during the second half of the season?

There's been a six-week break for the Ginetta Juniors since last running at Croft so as teams and drivers regroup, will there be any Snetterton surprises?



Daniel Lloyd broke a run of four race wins on the bounce for Bristol-based Zamparelli at Croft, but the race two result still hangs in the air because of a race two clash on the opening lap. Zamparelli retired and Lloyd continued on to his second win of the weekend.



The brace of victories has him provisionally closing to within 21 points of second place man Tom Carnaby in the points standings, but Zamparelli still holds a very comfortable 77 point lead.



This is the first time the Ginetta Junior Championship has visited this speedy Norfolk circuit since 2006 and so is a new circuit for most of the young 14 to 17 year old racers.



Dominic Pettit and Fergus Walkinshaw have both raced here in the past, but a select few have been testing here recently. Of the frontrunners, Carnaby and Lloyd looked strong, but then so did rookie Josh Hill.

Hill has had two third places and a runner-up spot so far and was all set for a win at Donington Park until a last-lap mistake. He's proved to be a strong fighter so will we see the 17-year old claim his first victory this weekend?



We also welcome newcomer Tom Howard to the grid for his first ever car race. Despite a small amount of karting, the budding young racer is comparatively inexperienced – so please applaud his efforts as he starts out.

The Ginetta G20 Senior counterparts are famous for their entertaining races around Snetterton. Judging by the Junior racing so far this season, there's everything to suggest these will follow in their tyre tracks!



• In addition to supporting the Ginetta Junior Championship at Snetterton this weekend, Ginetta also have support crews out at Brands Hatch with the Ginetta G20 'Seniors' in their Texaco Havoline Ginetta Championship, the Ginetta G50 Championship plus the British GT teams running Ginettas. And a third truck is heading off to Goodwood for the Festival of Speed running a Ginetta G50 road car.
