One of the original founders of Ginetta Cars, Ivor Walklett visited the current Ginetta factory this week, now owned by Lawrence Tomlinson.

Ivor Walklett is one of four brothers who set up the sports car company in 1958 and the designer of the famous Ginetta G4 car.
